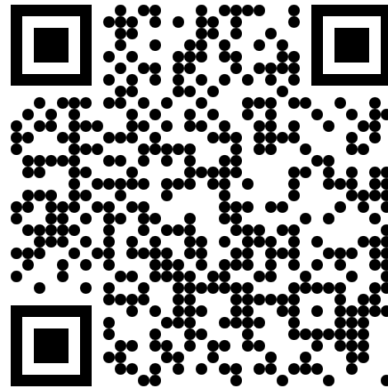

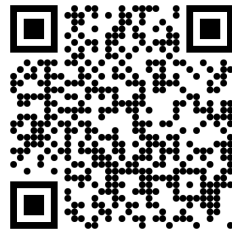

Background Clearances & Adult Leader Registration

- All adult leaders remaining at camp must be registered with the unit and be current in Safeguarding Youth Training
- PA residents must have current volunteer background clearances:
 - PA State Police
 - PA Child Abuse History
 - FBI fingerprint clearance (affidavit for 10+ years of residency)
- Out-of-state residents present signed affidavit

Compliance Verification

- 1) **PREFERRED:** One of the Unit's Key 3 members can access the unit's "SYT Aging Report." from "Training Manager" from their my.Scouting.org account. This report shows every adult on your charter and includes the SYT valid through date. You must be a registered Key 3 member to access. For instructions on how to obtain this report, contact your council registrar; **or**
- 2) Bring an unexpired unit registration card and a current SYT training certificate for each adult on the roster; **or**
- 3) Use either "SYT Clearance for PA resident" or "SYT Clearance for non-PA Residents" as appropriate. List all adults coming to camp. The primary unit's contact should sign the form. The form is then submitted to your local council's registrar who will verify the information and sign it.

Compliance Verification

These documents may be brought to Sunday camp check-in or submitted in advance to commissioner@ockanickon.org. Submitting these documents in advance will facilitate a much smoother Sunday check-in.

NO ADULT WILL BE PERMITTED TO STAY OVERNIGHT WITHOUT BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ABOVE.

Other Required Paperwork

1. Troop Rosters, both the youth and adult rosters are created in Tentaroo. The completed roster is needed at least two weeks prior to your arrival to allow for campsite and dining hall planning.
2. Unit Swim Record – If you are pretesting before arriving at camp, please submit your unit swim record at least two weeks prior to your arrival. Can be sent to: commissioner@ockanickon.org
3. Annual Health and Medical Record – If using the pre-check option, submit via mail **at least two** weeks prior to your arrival. Otherwise, must be complete upon arrival to camp.
4. Pre-Event Screening Form – Should be completed by all youth and adult participants prior to arriving in the parking lot at OSR. We DO NOT collect this form.

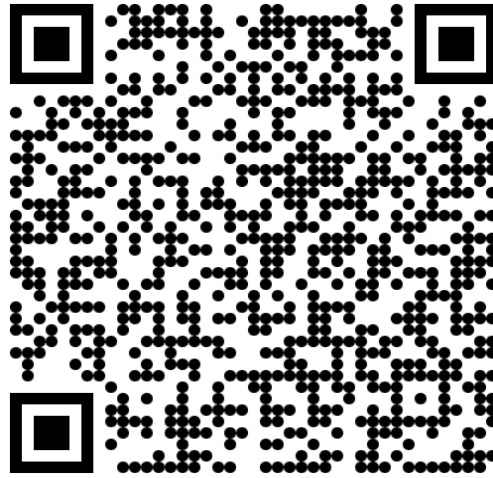
Sunday Check In
